



Admission Process

STEP 1: Complete NWC's online application and pay the \$50 application fee *northwestcollege.edu/intercultural/apply*

STEP 2: Email official copies of the following documents to—
international@northwestcollege.edu

- Financial Support Documentation
- English Language Proficiency Scores (TOEFL, iELTS, SAT, etc.) If you do not have one of these scores, you will take NWC's English placement test prior to arriving on campus.
- Transcripts & diplomas from secondary and any post-secondary institution you've attended
- A short essay describing your educational goals and reasons for attending NWC
- Copy of your passport—if you are transferring from another U.S. school also send a copy of your I-94 and I-20

Northwest College applications are accepted year-round. Mandatory International Student Orientations are in August and January.

Estimated 2014–15 Institutional Expenses

- *Eligible students may apply for limited scholarships during the international student orientation.
- **Health insurance in mandatory and all F-1 students will be enrolled in the NWC group policy. The cost of the insurance will be billed to your NWC student account.
 ***Room rate is based upon two people

per room (called double occupancy).
There is an additional cost for housing during vacation periods.
